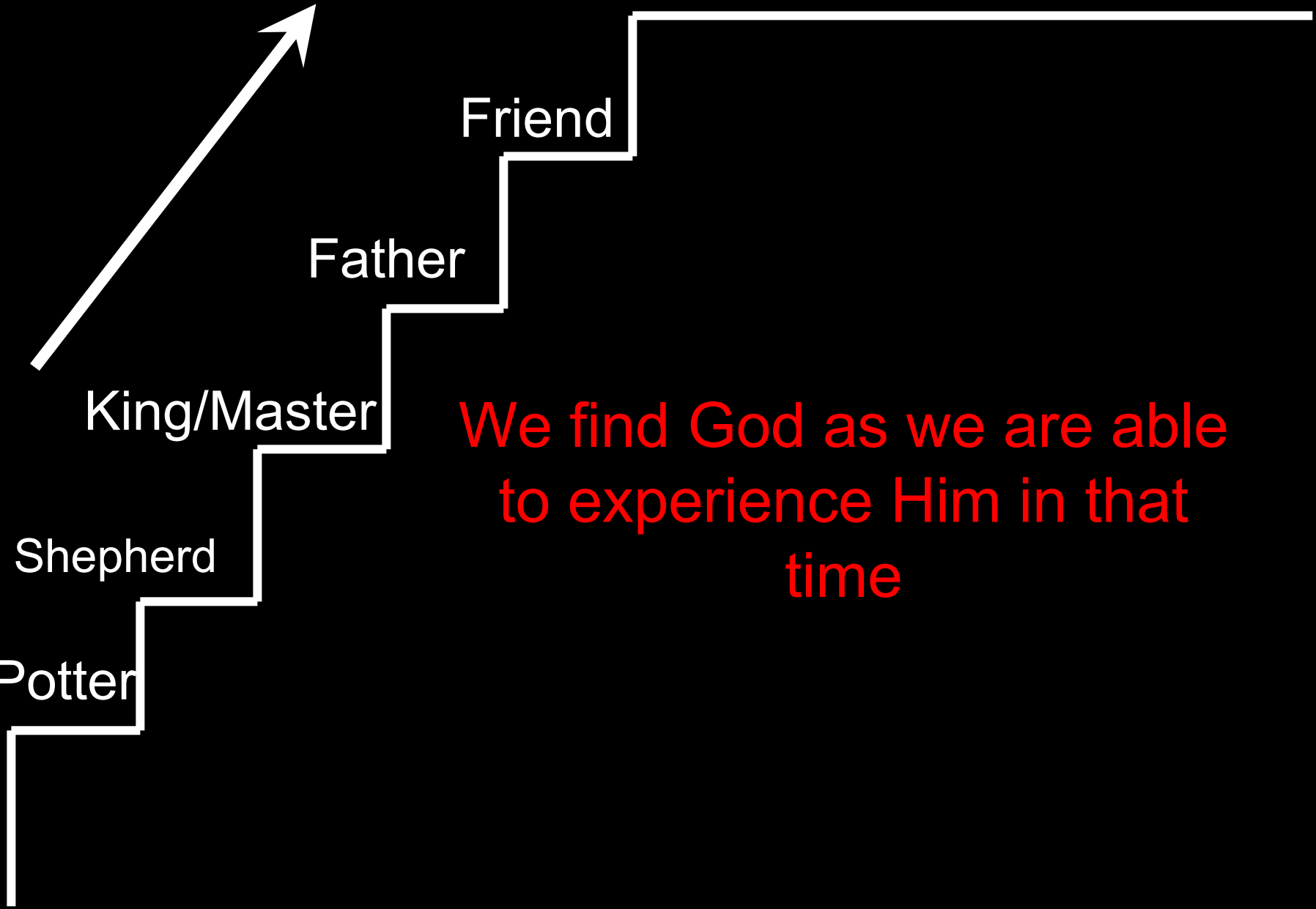

Lover

- a. Not only all I “need”, but he is all I “want”.
 - b. Finding Him deeply-walking with Him IS Life”
- Key word: “reward”

Friend

- a. On mission together, trusted and depended on.
 - b. Bear the marks of Christ’s suffering. Deep camaraderie.
- Key word: “Insider”

Father

- a. He wants to “re-Father” me. Give me what I missed.
 - b. I invite Him to redeem failures/blows - bestow a new identity on me “you can not only tell me what to do, but also who to be.”
- Key word: “Identity”

King/Master

- a. I realize GOD has an agenda and plan for my life and the world.
 - b. I see the sanity and rightness of that plan and choose to join Him.
- Key word: “Alliance” (in His employment)

Shepherd

- a. He will know what to do, where to go, what to eat, what to avoid.
 - b. He is truly dependable enough to follow and I realize I need Him
- Key word: “Dependence”

Potter

- a. God has the right to tell me what to do:
 - b. His leadership is absolutely necessary for me to have Life
 - c. “I must be completely pliable” “My ears are open and I’m listening”
- Key word: “Surrender”
